Customer Delivery Policies

• Please put caps on empties for pickup to keep **debris** from entering bottle.

To avoid charges for damaged bottles, please return them in good condition with no cuts, punctures, debris or dust inside of bottle.

• Bottles that are dirty or that had other liquid in them except our spring water, will not be picked up.

• BOTTLES THAT HAVE BEEN FROZEN DUE TO THE WEATHER are the responsibility of the customer. Cracked or damaged bottles from freeze are not acceptable and are not accepted for deposit credit.

• WE RECOMMEND YOU CLEAN YOUR COOLER EVERY 6 to 12 MONTHS.

HOW DO I CLEAN MY COOLER?

COOLER MAINTENANCE

Clean coolers every **6-12 Months**.

Please Note: If you have a hot/cold cooler, call our customer service center for instructions on the care/cleaning of your cooler. You can also find additional information on cleaning for hot/cold coolers on the reverse instead of following the steps outlined below.

Steps for cleaning non-hot/cold coolers:

Step 1: Remove empty bottle, unplug cooler from electric outlet and drain remaining spring water.

Step 2: Remove the spill guard on top of your cooler then remove the divider in the top of the water reservoir.

Step 3: Wipe the inside of the cooler with a clean dry cloth to loosen up the mineral deposits. Fill up reservoir with clean tap water and add only 1 teaspoon of bleach. Put divider in water. Do Not Use Anything Else But Bleach! Let stand for 5 minutes.

Do not put bleach in water bottles.

Step 4: Now drain bleach water from cooler thru both spigots and wipe inside of cooler reservoir dry with a clean dry cloth or paper towels.

Never drain cleaners into bottles.

Step 5: Now rinse your water cooler out, then fill up with clean tap water from a sink and rinse again. Keep record of last date cooler cleaned.
